If it were possible, I would like to changein the school

- The white shirts.
- Communication - too much!

- More notice about providing feedback.
- Sports day - some pupils participate individually in more than 1 event, while others only participate in team event! Very unfair and should be treated equally.
- Targeted classes for Y5 and Y6 to prepare children for move to a larger school and workload. Knowledge of assembly awards for attendance.
- More feedback on progress. We don't know what good looks like/specific areas struggling.
- Maybe some more clubs/activities to join.
- Less homework or homework club.
- Homework club.
- Update needed on décor in places.
- More use of the swimming pool.
- Change time of text notifications. They are sent at 7.45 am, no good for families using breakfast club.
