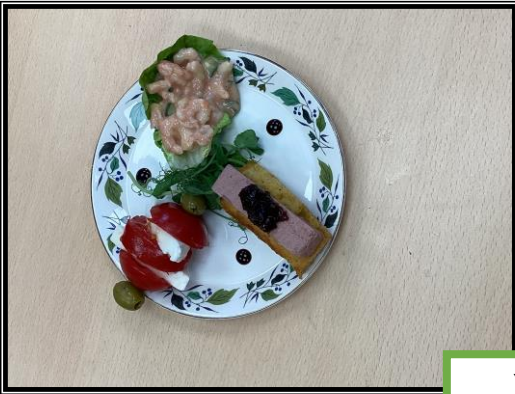

Advices and Queries, Quaker Faith and Practice

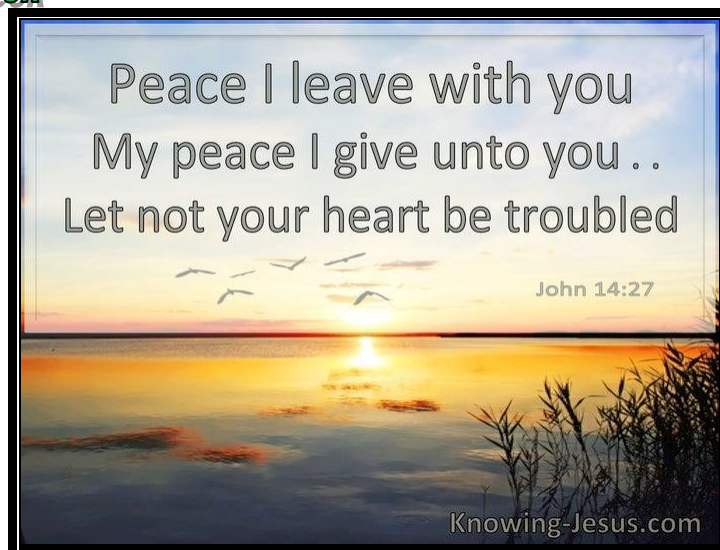

The Church will be open between 9.30am and 11am for you to drop in any time for tea/coffee and a chat.

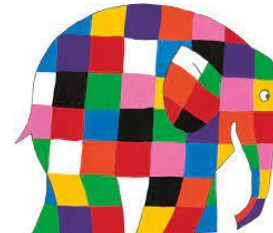
