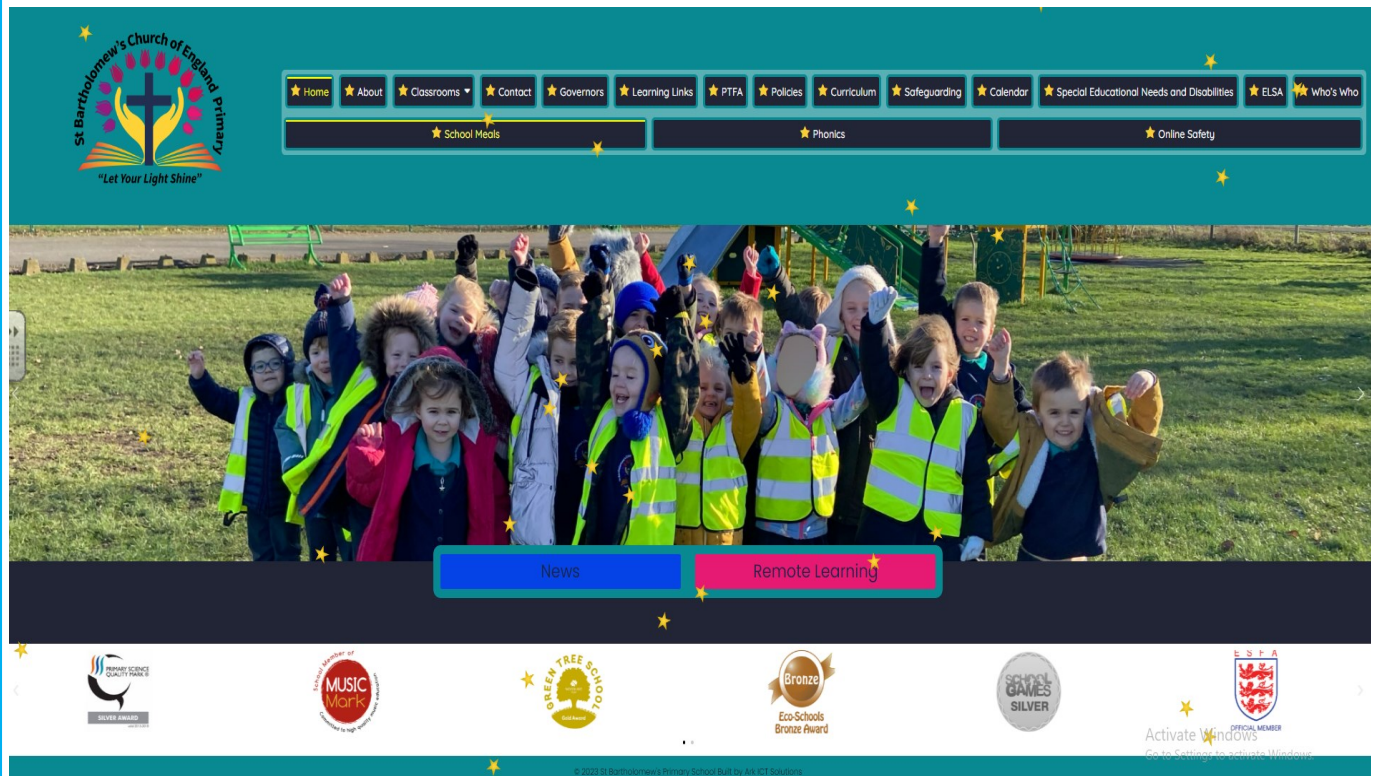

# Class News

**Apple Class:** Apple Class have had another very busy term. I cannot believe we only have one term left, this year is flying by and the children are having a fabulous time and learning lots.

This term, the children have learnt about transport and how we can travel to school. We have explored the journey of cars through time, placed modes of transport on a timeline and researched into famous people who invented different modes of transport. We were lucky enough to receive a visit from Mr Pallatt and his classic Ford Escort. Mr Pallatt and his son Tyler (Willow Class) told the children all about their classic car, shared the history of the car and told us some interesting facts about it. The children even got to sit inside it, which they loved!



In Science, the children have learnt about plants. We have named parts of plants, spoke about what each part does and took part in a plant hunt in school. We also learnt about trees and located various trees in the school environment. The children have enjoyed exploring seeds and planting in our exploration tray that Mrs S set up for us. Thank you Mrs S!



In order to celebrate the King's Coronation, we read the book called 'The King's Pants'. The children then designed their own pants for the King. We wrote a class letter to the King and we hope to receive a reply soon!

**Palm Class:** In the first summer term, Palm have explored a variety of new topics and learning opportunities. We have started our new English book 'Journey' where children have explored the fantastically illustrated book about a girl bored at home, so picks up a crayon and goes on an adventure. The pupils of Palm class have thoroughly enjoyed going on the adventure with the girl through role play and plenty of writing opportunities. At the end of term Palm are using this beautiful book to write a narrative alongside the pictures within the book, using time adverbials, expanded noun phrases, and extended vocabulary.



In mathematics our main focus for both year 2 and year 3 has been fractions. Palm class have worked hard on their maths, resulting in amazing fractional knowledge. Another focus for year 3 has been money, recognising what each coin represents and how to work out the correct change. This has been enhanced by creating a real-life situation, where we turned the classroom into a markets and pupils within Palm worked in pairs and created their own shop. They would go around and buy things, using their money, to sell in their shop. Pupils had to make sure they gave the correct change to their customer. Palm pupils had a fantastic learning experience, and we able to use their new skills with money.



During the middle of our summer term, Palm class joined the rest of the school in a beautiful coronation concert to celebrate King Charles II coming to the throne. With this Palm class practised their song, 'How far I'll go', everyday ready for the performance and performed beautifully on the stage. Well Done, Palm!



During this term we have re-opened our swimming pool, starting our swimming lessons again. Palm class have enjoyed going out into our warm pool and practising their swimming strokes, getting comfortable with the water, and pushing and gliding through the water.



At the end of the summer term year 2 worked extremely hard on their SATS. Palm class, around the SATS, have built amazing motte and bailey castles using cardboard and paper mache. This has linked to our topic this term learning about castles and their defences; therefore, Palm have added and highlighted motte and bailey defences within their designs and structures.

**Oak Class:** Our core values have been prevalent in Oak Class this term, where the children demonstrated how their trust in one another has grown to enable them to dream and achieve.

The buzz for learning has once again been alive in Oak Class, the drive and thirst to learn and better themselves is contagious and the children have thrown themselves into vast array of activities that have come their way. From comparing our local coastal regions, to writing to the Prince of Wales to share our views on the environment and the rainforest linked to our text in English, to learning about differing worldviews in RE about how to live a good life, the children have jumped at every opportunity to explore, diversify and gain extra knowledge and understanding. I am so proud of how Oak Class are growing into kind, intelligent and aware disciples of change who will go out into the world that we live in to make a difference.

The culmination of our learning this term, is our eagerly anticipated trip to Skegness, where the children will visit the Aquarium and undertake fieldwork on the beach to create a profile, recognise changes over time and identify some of the key physical and human characteristics of the coastline locally to us here at St Bart's.

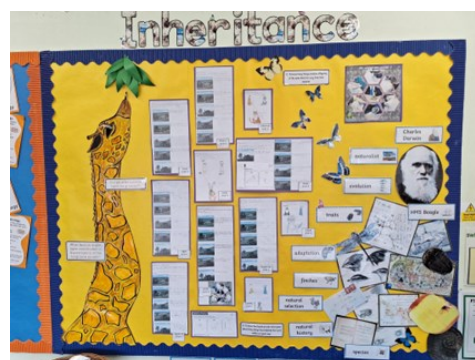

## Helping the Environment

**Clothing Recycling:** Our clothes recycling container has been delivered and is situated in the bike shed. If you wish to use it and the gates are locked, please let the school office know and a member of staff will open the gates for you. This facility is available term time only between 8.30am and 3.30pm. Your donations need to be deposited in a bag, however, please can we ask that you do not leave bags by the locked gates. This is a community facility and therefore is available for the wider community to use.

**Battery Collection:** Remember to bring in your used batteries (AAA, AA, C, D) for recycling. You can return your battery box or use the big battery collection box in the bike shed.

**Pen Recycling:** Remember to bring in your old pens, felt pens and markers for recycling. There is a recycling box in the bike shed. All writing instruments (except for wooden pencils and chalk) are accepted. We cannot accept glue sticks, erasers, rulers or other cutting objects.

**Ink Cartridges:** Remember to bring in your used ink cartridges and place them in the box in the bike shed. Please note toner and laser cartridges are not accepted as part of the programme. We will regularly inform you of the money we raise from your used cartridges.

**Uniform:** with the school logo is currently available to purchase via Parent-Mail, however the Sign Design Uniform shop situation in 14 Market Place, Spalding will be opening soon and will be stocking our uniform, further details to follow. Alternatively uniform can be sourced from Asda, Morrisons, Sainsbury's and M&S. Currently, M&S are the only stockist with our school colour of jade green summer dresses, however we are continually trying to source alternative providers. M&S summer attire is a comparable price to other high street brands and summer uniform is not compulsory.
