"Obviously with Christmas approaching 2024, me coming here with no penny to my name etc and then applying for universal credit etc etc I now have to learn how to work with finances for the very first time since.... Everything was new and with Christmas on the way..... it got kind of overwhelming, having priorities etc etc.

Now, I could easily explain to my kids (which I did) that Christmas they might get a gift or two, due to the fact that I just didn't have the money to make things happen for them. I felt guilty, I felt like I've taken them from a home with two parents and where they got gifts every year and I won't be able to give them that theyre used to during the Christmas holidays Etc... I had to keep on reminding myself of the importance of why I left yet I still feel guilty.

I can truthfully say, whoever donated towards our Christmas season they will never fully comprehend of just what their contributions meant to us, I will forever remember the looks of joy and excitement on the kids faces. Watching them jump up and down with joy and laughter was one of the greatest gifts you guys could have given. Any mother during this time especially whe she felt like she had failed her kids.

Now I know Christmas is not all about just gifts..... Its about being there, being present and loving each other but I can truly say you blessing us with all these generous and very very thoughtful gifts has been nothing sort of awesome. You brought so much joy and fulfilment and happiness not just on Christmas day but till today.

These kids looooooved there items and still play with it as if it was given to them yesterday.

I will forever cherish the looks on their faces and will never forget what joy and hope this day brought.

We were delighted to be selected as a Lincolnshire Coop Community Champion and received a fantastic donation of £765.


